- A kitchen caddy for food scraps
- A roll of compostable liner bags

WHEN DOES IT START?


- FOGO collections start mid-February 2020
- You will get a notice a week before collection starts
- FOGO bins go out on the kerb on the OPPOSITE week to your waste and recycling







GARDEN WASTE

Grass clippings, leaves, bark, weeds, small branches no thicker than your forearm

PAPER

Shredded paper, paper towels, paper napkins and tissues, compostable take-away food containers and pizza boxes

ANIMAL WASTE

Pet hair, organic kitty litter, soiled paper from birdcages. Pet poo yes, but NOT in plastic bags wrap in newspaper or put in compostable bags.
